MS Budget and Staffing:

- Local \$61,361
- Due to Family Income Surveys, we were able to recapture \$120,000.00. Title 1 budget is now \$581,129.00
- We will do training sessions next year to help families because this is extremely important.
- We may be able to afford a 3rd counselor.
- All teachers will be funded.
- We will share a bilingual “coach” to assist with strategy implementation.
- We will be offering a dance class next year as a PE course. This position will be shared with another campus.

Primary Budget and Staffing:

- Local \$16,000 and Title 1 \$219,361 with 99% low S.E.
- None of the staffing will need to change.

Scheduling Next Year:

- There will be a 9-week rotation for “Explorative” Fine Arts and “Explorative” Performing Arts. This should help with elective numbers.
